Thank you for your letter received on 9 February 2015 with a proposal requesting targeted support from the UN-REDD Programme.

I am pleased to inform you that the requested funding for support to the FREL/REL work in Cambodia and facilitate exchange on FRE/REL between Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Nepal and Viet Nam has been approved.

The UN-REDD Programme, through the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) will provide support for a total amount of US\$ 125,000. The targeted support will support Cambodia and the mentioned countries to deliver the results described in the proposal, including:

- Enhanced capacity to develop and submit a FREL/REL to the UNFCCC.
- Enhanced exchange between Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Nepal and Viet Nam on FREL/ FRL development.

It is noted that the support will build on the results from the National Programme. We would also like to encourage you to link this stream of work to the targeted support previously approved to Cambodia, as appropriate.
