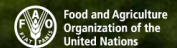

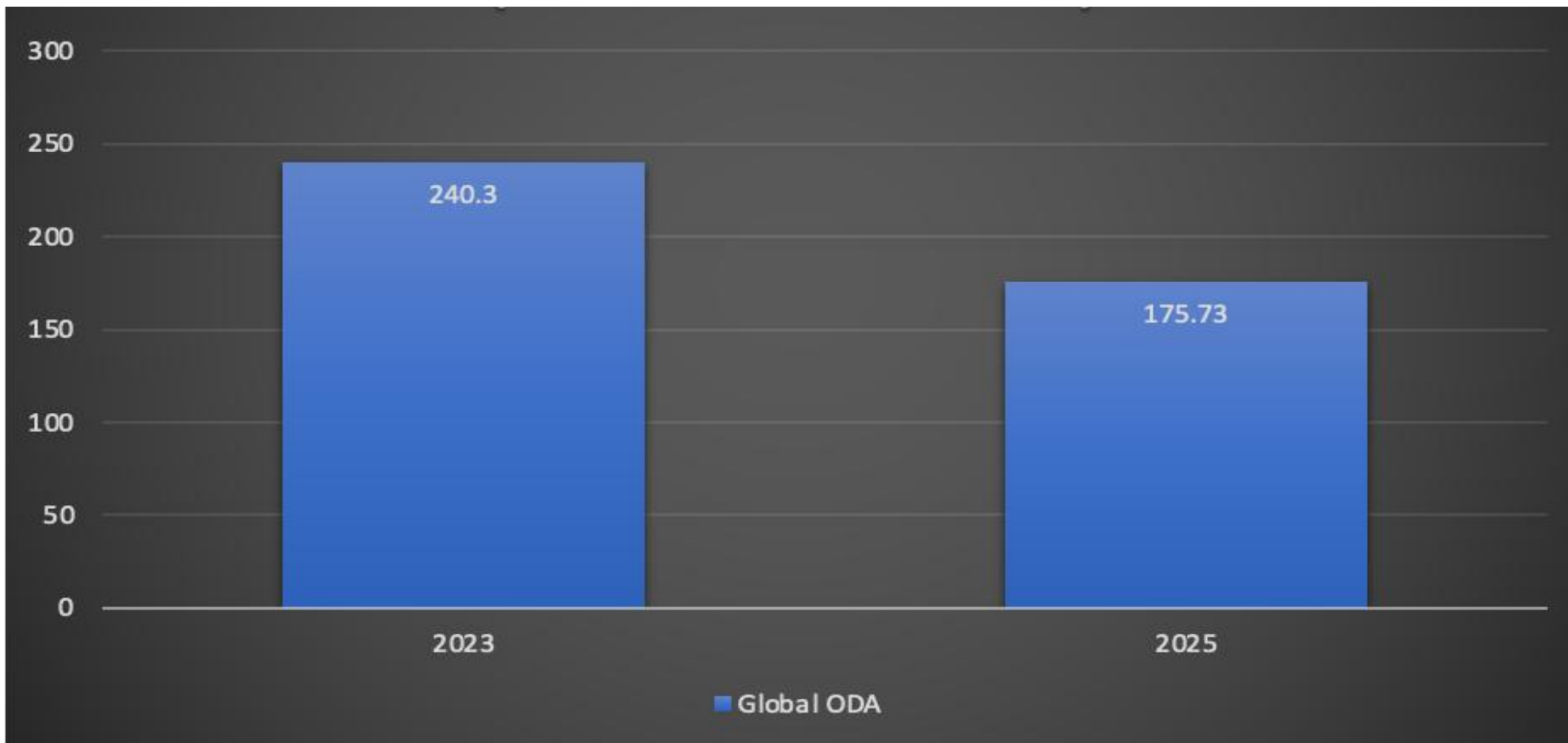

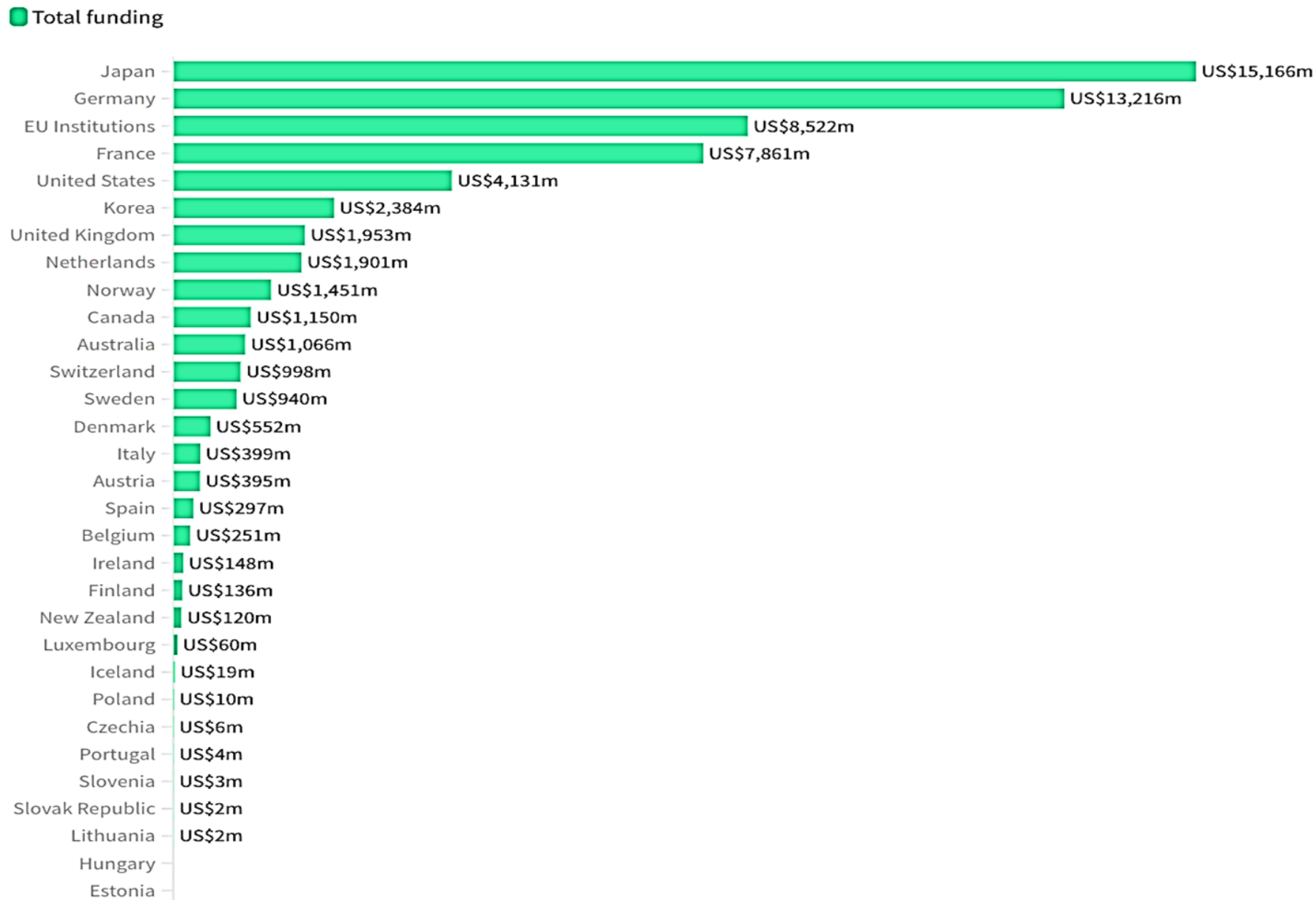

Global ODA Reductions 2023-2025

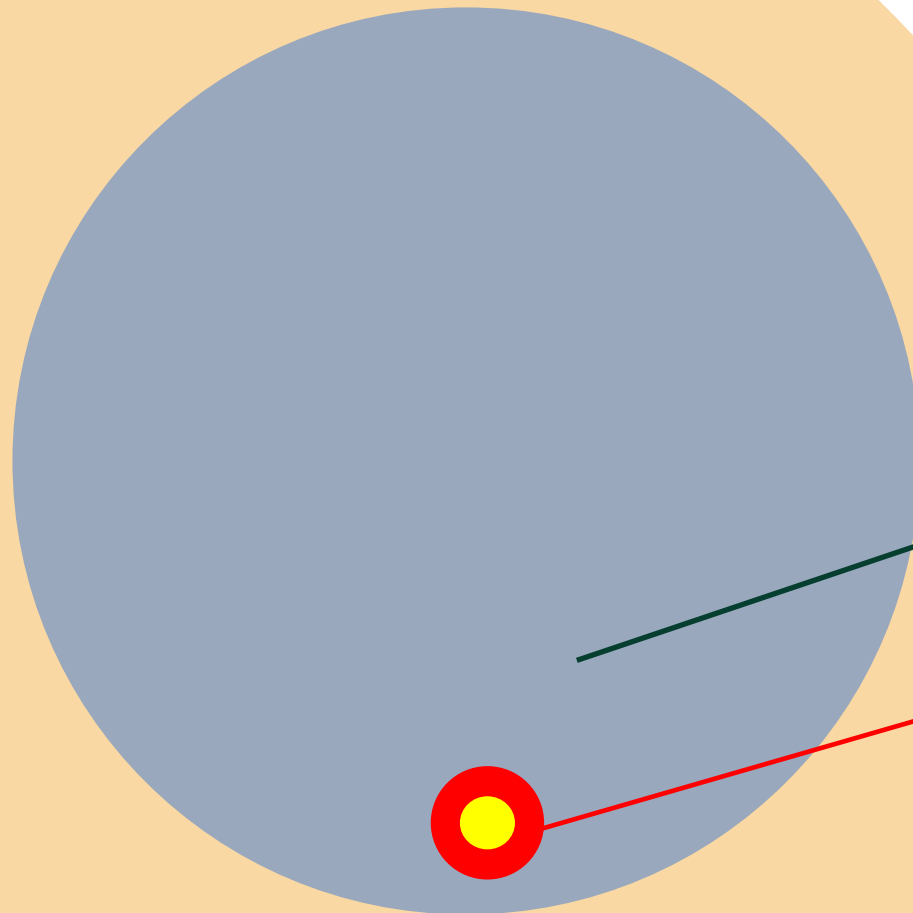
USD Billion 2023 constant prices (source: Donor Tracker)

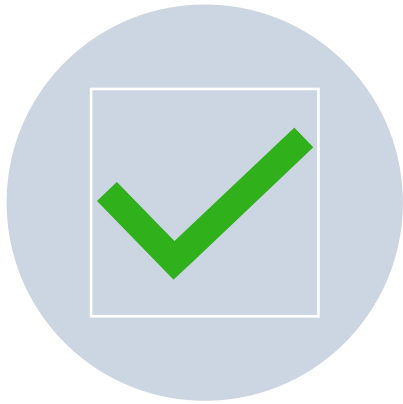

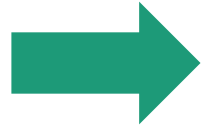
